# Lower Waihao Rural Water Scheme (including Waikakahi East)



### USERS ADVISED TO CEASE WATER CONSUMPTION

Nitrates levels within Lower Waihao Rural Water Supply (inc. Waikakahi East) have breached the maximum accepted value (MAV). All consumers on the respective water supplies should cease the use of the water for direct consumption and cooking.

Water for drinking and cooking is available to all Lower Waihao Rural Water Supply (inc. Waikakahi East) users at the following supply points:

- · Glenavy Hall, SH 1, Glenavy (Tank with tap)
- Morven Hall, MacLean Street, Morven (Tank with tap)
- 26 Studholme Street, Waimate (Tap located on street boundary)

Council is continuously monitoring the nitrates level and will advise consumers when it is safe to reuse the water supply.


