

We will have boarders present and attending families will be able to take away the Don House Hostel Handbook that gives an insight into the vision and values that Don House portrays and aspires to.



POSITIVE WAIMATE INC. EASTER BUNNY ROCK HUNT EVENT SATURDAY, 19 APRIL 2025



The event is organised by Positive Waimate Inc. in close cooperation with Waimate Rocks who provide the painted prize rocks and will be at the event.

POSITIVE WAIMATE WILL HAVE A BAKE SALE STALL TO FUNDRAISE FOR YOUR CHRISTMAS PARADE AND FAMILY FUN FAIR AS WELL AS FOR EVENTS LIKE THIS.

THE STALL AND WAIMATE ROCKS WILL BE UNDER THE CANOPY SO EVEN WHEN IT RAINS WE WILL BE DRY.

HOW WE PLAY THE GAME OF ROCK HUNTING:

- All children including year 8 can take part
- There will be two groups: Children \leq 5 and Children \geq 6 to Year 8
- Prize rocks will be distributed to all schools and early childhood centres in the week before school holidays
- · The rocks will be hidden at the school terrain for children to find
