Attendance Data-

Each term we receive a document from the Ministry regarding our schools attendance. Last term we received our attendance data which showed <u>that</u> we only have 49% of children attending school regularly. This data is extremely low and we discussed this at great lengths at our Board of Trustee Meeting on Wednesday night.


The data showed:

46% of children were away due to sickness

32% of children were away as they took a holiday during term time

13% of children were Justified to be away eg-Funeral

9% of children were away due to unjustified reasons - eg parents taking children out of school for no particular reason or to spend time with each other.



It is important to know that if your child misses too much school, this impacts on their academic learning. We know that it is important for children to go back home to their countries and spend time with family. There has been a lot of sickness last term, and we certainly do not want you to send sick children to school. But just think next time if you think your child is well enough to go to school. If your children want to stay home to help feed Calves or if your child wants to have a day with you in town, please say NO and send them to school. That is what weekends and holidays are for. 

This week the Glenavy Boomerangs played Weston Sharks and lost 6-1. Our player of the day went to Winter Dial.






