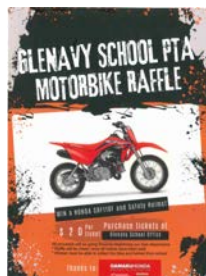
### Bus Ski Trip:

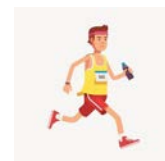

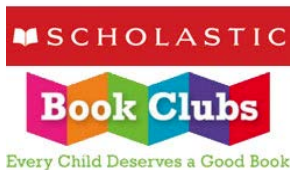


