This week, we're thrilled to welcome another new student to Glenavy School! Eros Dela Carsada joins us in Room Korora. Welcome to you and your family.

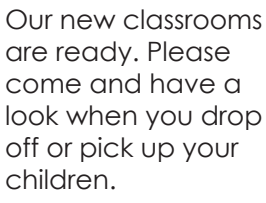
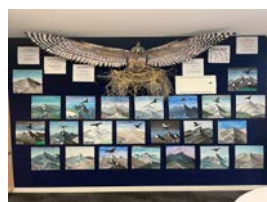


NEW CLASSROOM AND STAFF ROOM
