# **Down Hill Racer**

# Technology Day Home Challenge 2025 All years



#### Scenario:

It's time for the **Downhill Derby** in your town – it's the event of the year, the glory is there for the taking- your taking!

Your last-year's machine ended in a heap at the bottom of the hill, and your, er, bottom still feels the bruises...

...But this is another year, and with a complete redesign... well, anything can happen!

#### The Challenge:

Design and build an egg carton prototype of your racer designed to roll down a sloped board (1½ metres) and continue along asphalt pavement.

#### Materials:

- A full sized egg carton must be used!
- Any other materials allowed


#### Conditions - the racer must:

- Be under 40cm in any dimension
- Rely totally on gravity for its propulsion
- Be 'custom-built' no wheels from a previous life no ball-bearings for instance, or wheels flogged from prams, skateboards, toys, etc. **Judging Criteria:**

The winner will be the racer that travels the longest distance.

#### **To Think About:**

- Are big wheels or small wheels more efficient?
- Does a heavier or lighter vehicle go further?
- How can you minimize friction? Have fun!

# Hockey Results


This week the Glenavy Bluesticks played Weston Kiwi and lost 9-0 Our player of the day went to **Heath Harper**.
