Year 7 and 8's trip to the Museum

Friday last week the 7 and 8's attended a re-enactment of the 125th anniversary of Waikakahi Estate Property Ballot at the Waimate Museum.

The Waikakahi Estate - situated between the Waihao and Waitaki Rivers. Owned by Allan McLean, was one of South Canterbury's largest and most productive freehold properties. The 19,525 hectare Waikakahi Estate was purchased and subdivided by the government for denser settlement. A total of 2,283 applications were lodged by 686 people (some applying several times) for 142 sections. The ballot took place in the Waimate Courthouse over two days on the 28th and 29th March 1899.

It was fascinating to see how the land was divided up and even cooler that some of the land that was given out is still being farmed from Glenavy School Families today.



Farm Safety Day

This term we have been lucky enough to be asked to host a Farm Safety Day alongside Waihao Downs and Waituna Primary School. This event is being organised by children's author Harriet Bremner and is being sponsored by St John. We also have involvement from Oamaru Vets, Rural Transport, Timaru Honda just to name a few. This event is going ahead on Wednesday 29th of May here at Glenavy School.

The idea of the Farm Safety Day is to involve our community so that both parents and children are getting the Farm Safety messages. This is a particularly important message we need to be sending out not just to our children but even for us as Adults, especially with the increasing amount of farm place accidents that have been happening recently. This is a day when we want as many parents involved as possible. The way we are doing this is by asking you, our parents and community members to help out with the running of the modules and supplying the farm gear. You are the experts and the ones who play a major part in keeping our tamariki safe on the farm and that is why we need you to help us. More information will be heading home in the coming weeks.

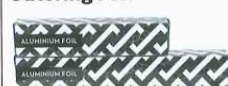

If you want to pay by credit card for your online Book Club order, **LOOP** makes it easy! It eliminates the need for paper order forms plus your online order is submitted to the school safe and sound.

Log-in to mybookclub.scholastic.co.nz or download our iPhone and iPad app from the App Store or get it on Google Play for Android.

- For a quick start, just click on **ORDER** in the top menu or **REGISTER** first to save your details for next time
- Select your school and your child's class
- Add your child's first name and last initial (so the school knows who the book is for)
- Enter the item number from the Book Club catalogue
- You can order for multiple children at once if they attend the same school
- All orders are linked directly to the school for submission to Scholastic. Books will still be delivered to your child's classroom if you order by the close date
- There's no need to return paper order forms or payment receipt details to your school!
