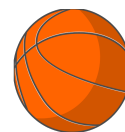

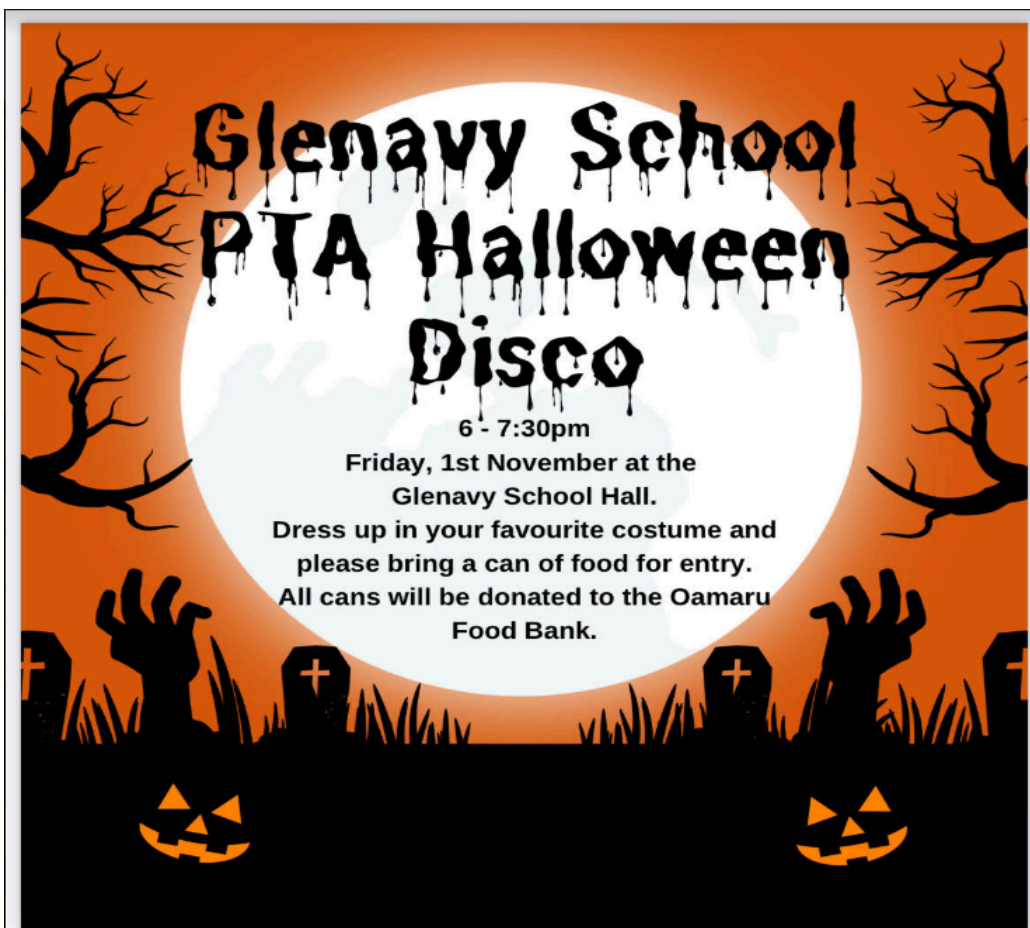
Pet Day Information for Friday 25th October
