Robyn will be continuing to drive the Flames Bus until further notice. Her phone number is 027 521 9070. Please ring or text her if your child is not going to be on the bus.

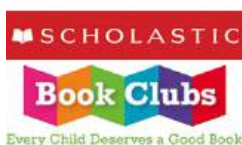
### **Do You Support a Waste-to-Energy Plant?**

Project Kea has been included in the list of projects added to the Fast-track Approvals Bill. Once the bill is passed, the process will be managed by the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) and an expert panel. Council may be given the opportunity to provide comments to the panel on the proposal, and would like to reflect the community's sentiment in our comments should we be provided the opportunity. Council wants to ensure that all residents, those in support and those opposed to the proposal, get to have their say on a waste-to-energy plant within our district through a community survey.
