PB4L-SW Update: As part of our Positive Behaviour for Learning, we have introduced House Tokens and Kahutara Cards to acknowledge expected behaviours and celebrate the great things that our students are doing at school. Students receive house tokens for showing The Kahutara Way OUTSIDE of the classroom at school events, during break times, on the bus and when representing our school. They put their house tokens in the house containers in our office foyer and we will announce the leading house at each assembly. This is a tangible and visible way to see how our students are making great choices and doing the right thing. We have also introduced 'Kahutara Cards' which are small cards that staff give out to acknowledge students showing our expected behaviours INSIDE the classroom. Students pop these into our Kahutara Cards mailbox, which is outside the office at the moment, and we do a draw at assembly each week.
