#### **Reminders & Upcoming Dates**

Health & Safety: Keeping everyone safe is a key priority for our Board. Please help us by modelling safe road crossing behaviour and using the designated crossing. This teaches our tamariki the skills they need to stay safe in the wider community. Tamariki coming to school on a bike or scooter must wear a helmet. We have received several community reports of students having near-misses with cars due to not being road aware. In 2026, we will be running a bike safety course for our senior students to support safe riding habits.

Cellphones: We continue to encounter issues with cellphone use at school, which takes valuable time away from staff. If your tamaiti needs a phone for after school, it must be handed into the office on arrival. Any phones found during the day will need to be collected by whaanau.

Attendance: Regular attendance is important for every child's success. To attend events and trips, students are required to have a minimum attendance rate of 75% - 80%, unless you have notified us that your child is unwell. Do the mahi, get the treats!

Sports Camp Payments: Thank you to the whaanau who have been making full or regular payments towards Sports Camp. Due to outstanding fees, Whanakee Hub will only have one outing to Waimarino this term. If you have not yet paid Sports Camp fees, please contact the office ASAP.

Uniform Update: Our supplier has informed us that the new uniform will not be ready for the first day of school in 2026. Once we have a confirmed arrival date, we will communicate how the rollout will take place. In the meantime, our current uniform will remain in place. Families will not be required to purchase new sets of the existing uniform, and exceptions will be made until the new uniform is introduced.
