Akonganga Wha has been busy 'building' their dream houses. They are still a work in progress, but we are looking forward to sharing it with everyone next Wednesday!

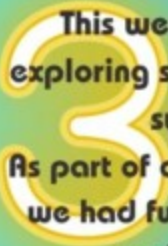
We have also been working hard on our squash skills, and having fun along the way!
