From the Principal

I am happy to warmly welcome all the new families joining KingsGate School. It is an absolute pleasure to educate your children, and we are committed to providing them with an enriching Christian educational experience that they will cherish.

Currently, I am watching an online sermon series on Nehemiah. Throughout my time at KingsGate, Nehemiah has steadily become one of my favourite books of the Bible. This is because parallels can be drawn from his experience and task to where we find ourselves as a school today.

In ancient times, city walls served not only to keep invaders out but also to give the city its identity. Without a city wall, a city was incomplete and vulnerable to invasions, which would change its identity with each conqueror. Conquering an unwalled city was easy in ancient times, so a city that lost its wall would often become deserted soon afterwards. However, a city with a wall gave its people a sense of identity, purpose, and protection. It allowed them to fight for what was precious and gave them hope and a shared focus.

I think back to our old location on Victoria Street. For over 20 years, KingsGate continued to build and strengthen its wall (its identity) on God's love, our faith in Him and the Hope that is Jesus Christ. Therefore, it is <u>our duty</u> to ensure that the same wall remains in place here at Blake Road. As we grow, we inevitably have those who don't want our wall to be strong. Much like Nehemiah experienced, some detractors will come from outside our community, and sadly, some will come from within. However, as Nehemiah exampled to us, prayer is our first resource, not our last resort, and prayer is one critical way our wall will be maintained.

Remember, membership matters at KingsGate. It is not something any of us should ever take lightly. As Nehemiah did as he rebuilt the wall, we serve one another, we carry the burden of one another, and we look after one another's well-being. Therefore, I would encourage you that when you speak of KingsGate School, you don't speak of "their school" but "my school", as we have all been blessed to play a small part in God's continuing narrative.

May you each have a lovely weekend and continue blessings in Christ.

Downloading the Skool Loop app - a step by step guide

Once you have downloaded the Skool Loop App, via either your Google Play or App store, please follow the below instructions to select your school -

- Open the Skool Loop App you will land on a welcome page.
- Click the 'Select your schools' this will bring you to a menu you can either search your school or follow the country/region prompts.
- Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side.
- Tap the 'select schools' button in the top right corner
- Tap the big orange choose button. This will load your school and bring you to the settings page.
- Subscribe to the groups that are relevant to you, then click the 'go back' button on your phone, which will bring you to the main screen of your schools app.
