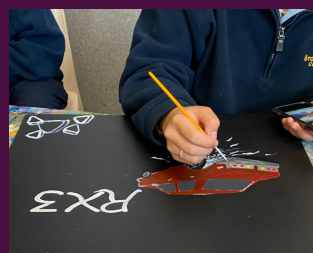
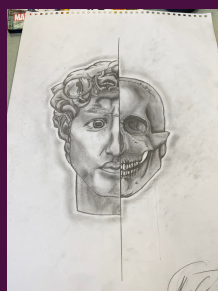


PERFORMING ARTS SHOWBIZZ MODULE
