#### **Activities for Students and Volunteers:**

- Marking out and hoeing rows
- Compost spreading and digging in
- Planting trees and companion plants
- Mulching and watering

Students will be hands-on throughout both days, supported by staff and community volunteers.

#### How you can help on the day:

- **Lend tools:** We would be very grateful for the loan of rakes, spades, wheelbarrows, and trowels. Please ensure they are clearly named so they can be returned.
- Lend Labour. We would appreciate any time you can give on either day for rotary hoeing the grass, mulching, wheel barrowing, planting etc.

Why this matters: Fresh food prices are rising, supermarket produce travels many food miles, and much is wasted before it even reaches families. Our Mara Manaaki Food Forest will show students (and their whānau) how growing locally is healthier, cheaper, and better for the planet.


