Potential Change of our School Name

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, a survey will be sent out next week to seek feedback from the community regarding changing our name from *Kamo Primary School* to *Te Kamo Primary School*. Kamo Intermediate School has made the change, and Kamo High School is in the process as well.

To quote, on 9th August 2023, "Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aotearoa New Zealand Geographic Board announces today that the Whangārei suburb of Kamo has been renamed Te Kamo. Board Chairperson Anselm Haanen says the proposal to make Te Kamo official was made by Ngāti Kahu-o-Torongare and several hapū to better honour the rangatira/tupuna it was named for. Their historical narratives refer to Te Kamo as a notable leader and ancestor in the area.

The original name of the land and kāinga (village) was Te Kamo, and we can see this reflected in the record of the Crown's purchase of the 'Te Kamo' block in 1858," says Mr Haanen."
