### Reading, Writing and Mathematics

I am just wanting to reassure you all that your child/ren have been receiving instruction in Reading, Writing and Mathematics every day as required, and as we have done for many years. Term 4 will see teachers working with and assessing students in these three areas, and this of course will be reported to you at the end of the year. You will also know from your child/ren that Structured Literacy does take place, and has done at Kamo Primary School for a few years now.

#### Swimming - Term 4

Swimming will start in Term 4 but not straight away; we will notify you in advance of when it will start. We have to get consistent temperatures before we open the pool for use. Once swimming starts, we expect all students to participate, as it is part of the curriculum. A note will be required if your child is not able to swim due to illness. We will start with our pool's heaters going and will gradually dial back the temperature as it warms up. We expect swimming gear to be named and a wet swimming bag to be provided. We look forward to another great swimming season.

#### Hat Wearing - Term 4

Term 4 will see students wearing hats in the playground that we provide at school. To our new whānau, this is an expectation that our hats are worn outside. Your child/ren will be given a dedicated hat and the school maintains the hygiene of the hats. They will not leave the class without it on and they are to return to class with it on. If the hat is not on, they will not play outside. Please support your child to wear the hat provided.

#### **Water Bottles**

During the autumn and winter months we tend to see water drinking drop off. We value water being consumed by our students and ask that filled water bottles are a regular in school bags again please. We know from the experts... "Water helps our brains and energy levels. A drink of water can help people concentrate and stay refreshed, alert and more focused. If the body is needed to concentrate for long periods of time, water will support the brain and body. Dehydration can impair your attention span, memory, and motor skills. Dehydration causes shrinkage of brain tissue." So, when we haven't been drinking enough water, our brains have to work a lot harder to perform at the same level.

Friday 27th September is of course the last day of Term 3 and school closes at the normal time of 3:00pm. Term 4 starts on Monday 14th October at our usual time of 8:55am. Term 4 finishes 12 noon Tuesday 17th December
