## **2024 INFORMATION**

## **BELL TIMES**



School begins at 8:45am, with children allowed into rooms from 8:15am. Our day finishes at 2:45pm. We have two half hour play breaks during the day and three opportunities for kai (food). The play breaks are from 10:00-10:30 am and 1:15-1:45pm.

### **SCHOOL BREAKFAST & LUNCHES**

Unfortunately Parkvale School has yet to be included in the free lunches in schools programme run by the Government, which so many other Hawke's Bay schools have been fortunate to be part of. We are fully aware that a number of students for various reasons require extra nutritional support during the school day and for this reason we operate a breakfast and lunch club where students can go to during breaks to top up their nutritional needs. Currently we have been able to source suppliers who have donated - Weetbix, Cornies, Ricies, Milk and Bread as well as spreads. All students are most welcome to enjoy this nutritional extra opportunity.

## **HATS**

School hats are compulsory in Terms 1 & 4. These can be purchased through the school office for \$12.50

#### **SWIMMING**

We swim for the first half of Term 1 (or as long as the weather allows) and the second half of Term 4. Please make sure your child brings their togs every day as the weather can change. Please make sure togs, towels, goggles are named and your child has a bag to put their clothes into while not swimming.

## **COMMUNICATION**

There are many ways to stay informed of school happenings and information. Our School Facebook page is a key resource along with the Seesaw app, which you will receive information about joining in the first week of school. School newsletters are sent out digitally via Facebook and Seesaw.

#### SCHOOL STRUCTURE

Our school is made up of Nga Rakau Iti (the little trees), which is our junior school consisting of years 0-3 and Nga Rakau Nui (the big trees), which is our senior school consisting of years 4-6. These are often referred to as The Iti (Junior School) and The Nui (Senior School).

Within the Iti and Nui, classes are broken into Branches. Three in the Junior School: Pōhutukawa Branch Yrs0-1, Kawakawa Branch Yrs 2 and Kōwhai Branch Yrs 3. The Senior School has two branches Nīkau Branch Yrs 4 & 5 and Mānuka Branch Yrs 5 & 6.

We run a House System at school for events and house points. Houses work across the school so Iti and Nui children can work together. Once your child has started and are in our computer system a house will be assigned to them, siblings are placed in the same house together. Your child's house name and colour will be given to you within the first few weeks of school. The school office sells House T-Shirts for \$15, these are not compulsary.

#### **CLOTHING**

Please make sure all items of clothing are named as this allows lost uniform to be returned to its owner. It is very difficult to reunite lost clothing when it is un-named.








## **FUN SWIMMING SPORTS**
