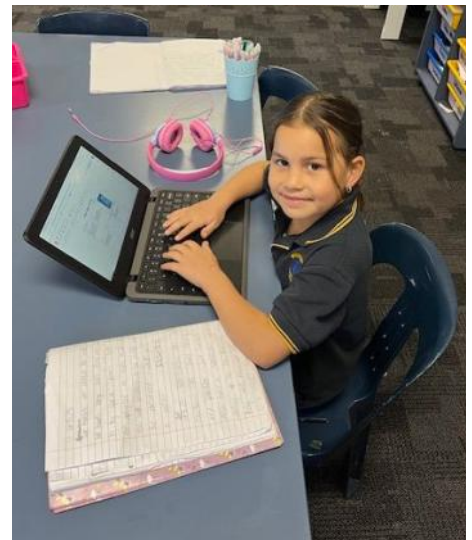
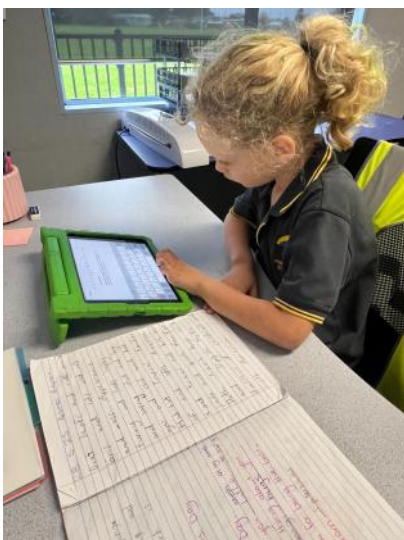
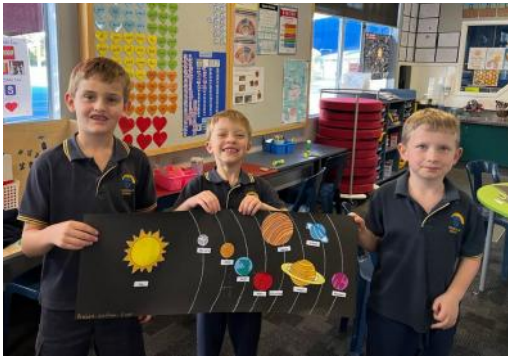

Then they watched the fireworks and they were all oooooohhhhhh and aahhhhh.

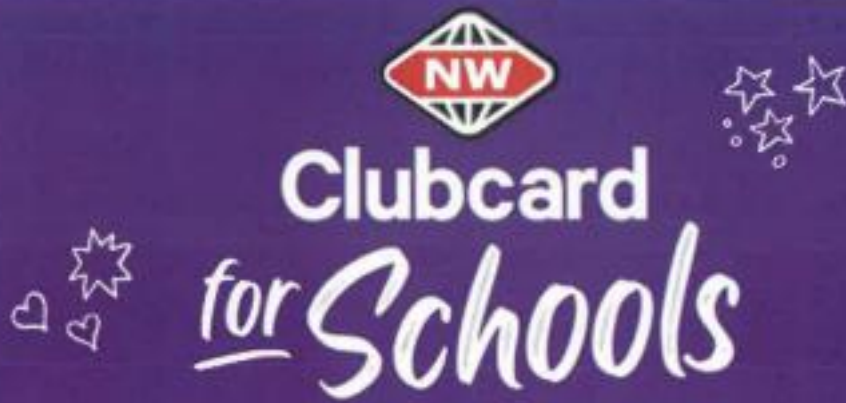
