## Tēnā koutou Whānau,

I cannot believe that next week is the last week of term! This school year is flying by, and we have certainly had an incredibly busy term filled with exciting events and learning experiences. Our tamariki have had fantastic opportunities to engage in various activities, including: Stardome EOTC visit for the Senior students, Kelly Tarlton's Trip, the Herd leaders attended the GRIP Leadership Conference, Swimming Sports, Summer Sports, as well as the upcoming trip next week to Woodhill Tree Adventures for our Y7 & Y8 students.

A special highlight for our junior team this term was their EOTC visit to Kelly Tarlton's on Wednesday, 26th March, we have posted some great photos and writing in the newsletter today.

Next Friday we will be holding our annual Easter Hat Parade, sponsored and judged by Tracey Howe from Harcourts Cooper & Co. All children are invited to decorate a hat or cap at home and bring it to school on the morning of Friday 11th April 2025. There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, and a small Easter treat for every child who enters.



Looking ahead to Term 2, we already have plans in place. Our major inquiry learning focus for the whole school next term will be on our local history and preparing for Matariki at the end of June. Our tamariki will be exploring the rich cultural heritage of our local area and Aotearoa. Connections will be made to their learning from this term as well.

We have also organised a 4 day camp for all the Year 6, 7, & 8 students at Lakewood Lodge, Huntly from Tuesday 27th—Friday 30th May. This will be a wonderful outdoor experience for our oldest learners who will be taking part in activities such as horse riding, archery, a climbing wall, ropes course, a water slide, burma trail, and flying foxes, and a great opportunity to get out of their comfort zone experiencing new things.

Thank you for your support with our Term 1 Friday ice block fundraiser and thank you to Kirsty Hodd and Makayla Lawson for giving up their lunchtime each week to sell them. So far this year we have raised over \$815 which will be used to purchase additional resources for our students to use, such as the EPRO8 kit so that our Y7 & Y8 students can prepare for the EPRO8 challenge later in the year. Your support is greatly appreciated. Our next focus will be on raising funds for structured literacy games for the junior area of the school as well as enhancing our play spaces.

Pete and his team have continued to work their magic in proud supporter of your our school gardens. The students in Rūma Toru have been very excited to see the new grass growing outside their classroom and can't wait to get to play on it. looking forward to this area being finished We are and watching our learners explore the hands-on learning opportunities the area provides.

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
# JUNIOR EOTC VISIT TO KELLY TARTLTON'S

A special highlight for our junior team this term was their EOTC visit to **Kelly Tarlton's** on Wednesday, 26th March.



# **New Zealand Traveller Declaration**

Going overseas for the school holidays? Everyone travelling into New Zealand must complete a New Zealand Traveller Declaration, including returning New Zealand passport holders.

Its FREE and you can do it on the <u>online form</u> or on the <u>NZTD app</u>.

If you're travelling as a family or group and completing multiple declarations, the <u>NZTD app</u> allows you to copy your travel details into another declaration, making it easier to complete multiple declarations for the same journey. The submitted declarations are then all easy to see within the app.

The New Zealand Traveller Declaration collects travel, customs, immigration and biosecurity information and aims to improve the safety and security of New Zealand. It replaces the paper card you used to fill out on the plane.

To make your arrival easier, do your digital declaration before your flight back to New Zealand.
