There is a definite scientific buzz about as I walk around Waitoki School and it is great to see our tamariki so engaged in their learning. The students have been enthusiastically explaining all about the experiments and dissections that they have been doing using scientific language. Some of the students have also been keen to share with me how their individual scientific investigations (science boards) are developing. This is a great segway into the learning experiences our Y4 - Y8 students will have when they attend the Science Roadshow on Wednesday 29th May.

On Monday 6th May six of our Y5 - Y8 students represented Waitoki School at the World Vision Youth Leadership Conference in Auckland. Throughout the day the students explored topics such as climate change, pollution and how they can take action to make a difference. Our tamariki who attended found the day really worthwhile.



There are a couple of opportunities coming up for our students to connect with other learners from the schools in our Kaipara Kāhui Ako. Next week, on Friday 24th May, we have a group of 19 tamariki going to the Wananga at Helensville Primary. In preparation for the inter school Rippa competition later in the term we have Rippa Activations coming into school for four sessions over the next few weeks to help to train our students.
