School Closure - Nationwide Educators' Strike

This notice is to inform you that our school will be CLOSED for instruction on Thursday, 23 October 2025, due to a nationwide strike by members of NZEI Te Riu Roa.

Details of the Closure:

- Date of Closure: Thursday, 23 October 2025
- School will re-open: Friday, 24 October 2025, at the usual time.

The Strike Action:

The industrial action is a legally protected strike involving NZEI Te Riu Roa members across Aotearoa, including:

- Primary Teachers
- Primary Principals (myself included)
- School Support Staff (e.g., teacher aides, office staff)

The decision to strike is never taken lightly, and we understand this may cause disruption for your family. Our staff are advocating for investment in education, seeking better pay and conditions that will help to address teacher and principal shortages, and ensure all students, especially those with additional needs, get the support they deserve.

Why the School Must Close:

As the vast majority of our staff are union members and will be participating in the strike, we cannot guarantee the required level of supervision and support to ensure the health and safety of your children. The Board of Trustees has therefore made the difficult but necessary decision to close the school for the day.

We sincerely appreciate your understanding and support as we collectively work to ensure a strong future for our education system and for our tamariki.
