Kawa Kiwi Award


This week's KAWA KIWI is awarded to Vann Saywell.

Key Event Details

- Time: 9:30 a.m. to 2:15 p.m.
- Location: Cambridge Athletics Grounds
- Transport: We will be taking a bus from school, departing at 9:00 a.m. and returning by 3:00 p.m in time for regular bus routes and pick-up. Some senior students may need to travel in Mrs Buckle's car, as the bus has limited seating.
- Cost: Thanks to our wonderful PTA's sponsorship, the bus and event are completely free!
- Parent Support: We'd love to see you there to cheer on the athletes! If you plan to take
 your child directly to or from the event, please let us know beforehand. Also, be sure to
 sign them out on the sheet provided on the day if you leave the grounds with your child.
