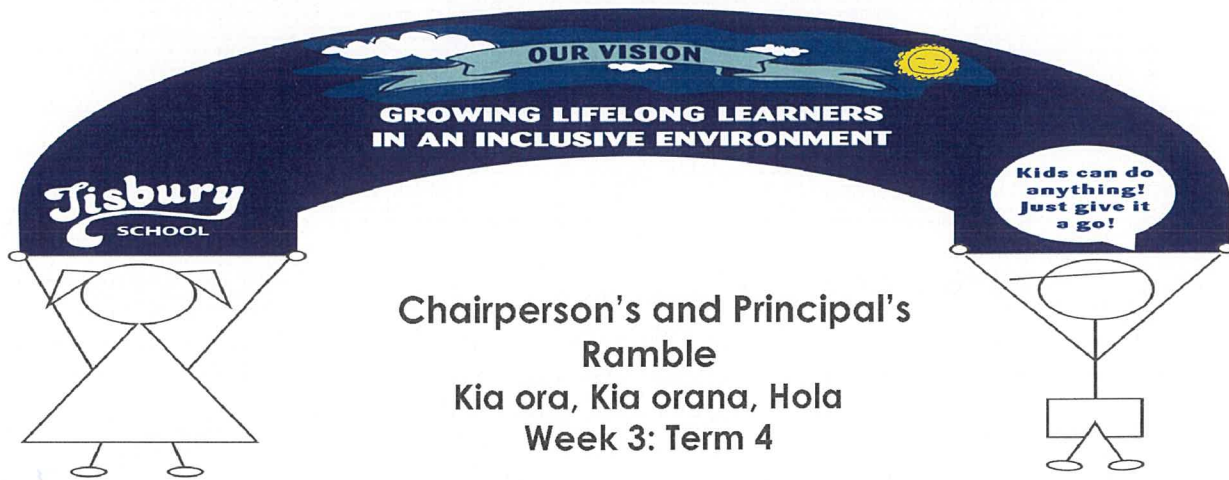

### REMINDER DATES - please note some of these dates may have changed:

#### Beach Education Programme

Thursday, 21st November - Seniors at the Surf Life Club / Oreti Beach : ratio of 1:5 helpers required.

Friday, 22nd November - Juniors at the Surf Life Club / Oreti Beach : ratio of 1:5 helpers - but the more the better. See note on HERO that went out on Wednesday, 30th October for details. #### CURRICULUM

As reported in the news lately, the government has provided schools the opportunity to receive a math resource to support the great teaching that is already happening at school. The two options that we have chosen to supplement our math resources with are:

Years 0-3: **Numicon** - oral language and equipment based  
Years 4/5/6: **Oxford Aotearoa** Maths and Statistics

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Staff will begin professional development around the implementation of the revised math curriculum moving into their understanding as to how the above resources can support their teaching programmes.

We will be using Officemax again for our back to school stationery. Teachers are currently creating lists and once these are confirmed, further information will come out. It is highly recommended that you order early (even in December) and payment can be made in January.

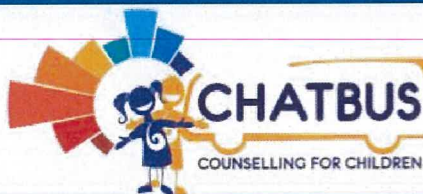
**Final Tisbury School Board of Trustees Meeting for 2024 : Tuesday, 26 November.**
