

This week, teachers and students have been collating information for Student Portfolios, that will be sent home to parents on Friday of Week 9. The portfolios will contain current achievement levels across a range of subjects, samples of work, evidence of learning, teacher and student assessments, teacher comments and a principal's comment. They will also include information about your child's teacher and class for 2025.



For reporting purposes, we have always used a mix of standardized assessment tools and school-based assessment tools at Flanshaw Road School. Standardized assessment tools provide strong, reliable benchmark information. Because they are used from school to school, when our students go to Intermediate, it is important that they know these tools and how they work.

The school-based assessment tools we use, ensure we assess what has been taught, for example what a class have focused on in Te Reo lessons, or skills students have developed in a medium of visual art. Criteria developed aligns with the bespoke units of work that have been designed to engage students, as well as cover different strands of each curriculum. At Flanshaw, we celebrate rates of progress a lot, because progress made is closely linked to effort put in. By comparison, achievement levels are the milestone a student is "at" in one moment in time. It is not fixed. It is not forever. It is a step on the way to "the next learning goal".

In other news, this week we have welcomed Katie Mareva to our school. Katie is our new bursar. Please introduce yourself if you meet her in the office, to help her begin to get to know our community.

In the next week, as well as prepping for end of year events, teachers, staff and students will be shifting furniture, as we prepare for internal classroom upgrades to begin. Having three building projects happening concurrently is a challenge. But, like the road works that have been done either side of the school, eventually, they will be done and what is left will be better than what was there before.
