#### Problems with parking – and managing our manners:

This week, we have had some 'incidents' at different entrances in the school. We encourage parents to park away from school gates and entrances. This is so students establish a routine of walking part of the way to school and so parents don't create congestion at the gates.

The 'drop off zone' between the hall and Karaka Classroom is not a carpark, especially between 8.30 am and 9.00 am and 2.50 to 3.25 pm. If it is going to take you more than a couple of minutes to collect your children please park on the road, not in the driveway. After 2.30 pm, there are some carparks on the far side of the hall that can be used for parking.

On the Vera Road side of the school, the sight lines for students going to and from school using the crossing can be difficult because of parked cars, moving traffic and the curve in the road. Please be patient when dropping off your children. Speak to people courteously and use language that is appropriate. 'Ngā whakapiringatanga' is about creating optimum conditions for learning. This starts with all our students, staff and whanau being safe as they come and go from school.
