

 or follow the country/region prompts.
- . Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side.

Sunhats and Foo

We have noticed that some students do not have a school hat and footwear appropriate for school. It is really HOT in the middle of the day, so students do need hats and sun-screen (Flanshaw will provide sun-screen for students who do not have their own). Regarding footwear, we ask that students wear sandals with straps or trainers. Students cannot do fitness in jandals and our concrete is rough and hot on bare feet. The sun is so hot at the moment on the concrete that it can cause blisters on the soles of their tender feet.
