Excitement is building as we approach our 'Whole School Show' date (25th September). Thank you to parents and whanau who are helping with costumes and class items. Your support makes a huge difference as we work through the process of preparing for production. Letters went home on Monday, requesting permission to take your child, by bus, to Church Unlimited on the 25th September, for a final rehearsal. Please make sure permission slips are signed and returned to your child's teacher. Tickets are now on sale at the school office.



Speaking of the school office, from the 12th September, our reception area will be relocated to the Principal's office. You will need to follow the signs to the "new" office area on the playground side of the Administration Building. While the Administration Building and library are being upgraded, we will have a range of contractors' vehicles coming and going from the front carpark and it is critical we keep all our community safe while this work is being done. Recently, we have had a lot of new students starting school. If you are walking your child to or from class, please walk along the designated footpaths if you use the Flanshaw Road School entrance.

Speaking of footpaths, we have been in discussion with the Auckland Transport team in charge of upgrading the footpaths along Vera Road this week. The upgrade of footpaths along Vera Road is starting on the 13th September and will take approximately eight weeks. This means Vera Road, from Grainger Road to Royal View Road, is to be closed to all traffic except for residents. That means the school carpark will be available for staff only. We have been told that the footpaths will be replaced one side at a time, so students will be able to continue to come to and from the school.

If you are a parent who drops their child off by car, it could be time to change the routine, so you drop your children one block, two blocks or a street away from school, so they can walk to and from school. This will reduce congestion at the gate, as well as improve our 'Travel-wise Walking to School' statistics.

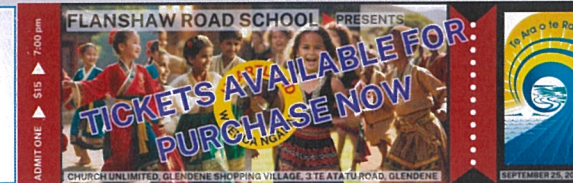
