

Two weeks ago, I attended an Auckland Council meeting to support Te Kawerau-ā-Maki's deed to cogovern the Waikakere Ranges Heritage Area. This regional park, approximately 27,000 hectares in size, was the first to be established in New Zealand.

At the hearing, various people spoke. Sandra Coney, a former councillor, shared that in 1940 the people of Auckland were asked to prioritize a legacy project, to celebrate the centenary of 'Ti Tiriti o Waitangi' being signed. The people of Auckland chose to establish the Waitakere Ranges as a regional park. Back then, I am sure they would not have realized how important their decision would become. Trees absorb carbon, create oxygen, cool the earth and us. They sustain ecosystems of insects, birds and wildlife - and are a major solution to combat global warming. Our students are lucky to be growing up in West Auckland, so close to the Waitakere Ranges.

Tomorrow, some staff will be wearing purple. Organized through the NZEI union, it is a day to recognize our Learning Support Staff and to highlight the 0% pay increase they have been offered by the government. We have thirteen multi-talented support staff at Flanshaw Road School, that help make every day the 'best possible day' for our students.
