New Entrant Transition and Settling-In Program

At St Leo's School we are committed to ensuring that our new entrant students have a smooth and positive transition into school life. Our Transition and Settling-In Program is designed to provide a nurturing and welcoming environment, reflecting the Mercy values of compassion, respect, and care.

Led by Anna Rumble, a valued member of our teaching team and Board of Trustees, the program runs over 4 weeks. During this time, children gradually transition into the Year 0-2 class, receiving tailored support to help them adapt to their new learning environment. This is followed by an additional two weeks of ongoing support to ensure they are fully settled and thriving.



The program focuses on core curriculum areas such as literacy, numeracy, and social-emotional development, helping students build foundational skills while fostering confidence and independence. Activities are designed to align with the school's commitment to excellence in education and its nurturing ethos, ensuring every child feels supported, valued, and ready to learn.


