This pānui is to share information with our school community about some changes and innovations in our school this term and next.

By agreement with the current principal, from Monday 11th March, 2024 I will be the acting principal until the end of the term. As you are probably already aware, I will take on the role Principal of Tongariro School from the beginning of term 2.

We have a Limited Statutory Manager who will be working with the leadership of the school to review and further develop and support our curriculum and pedagogy review. He will be in school one day a week for the rest of the year.

From the beginning of next term, a monthly update will be sent out to whānau to keep you informed of activities in the school. For the rest of the year there will also be a monthly informal hui where whānau can ask specific questions around curriculum and processes, property development and others. These will take place between 8:30am - 9:00am on a Tuesday. Further information will be sent out in due course. Initially, depending on demand, I may organise more than one so that we can split into junior and senior school in order to allow more time to address any questions there may be that are specific to the two sectors.

Where reasonably possible, I welcome parents to make an appointment about any concerns or questions they may have. This can be done through the front office. I would welcome the opportunity to speak to you.

Our school is a community asset: it exists to serve the needs of the young people in our community and we looking forward to working with you.
