



Hiwinui School (02364)
Enrolment Scheme
Effective from 30th April 2018

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G (3) of the Education Act 1989 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below and/or shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

All students who live within the home zone described below (and as shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at Hiwinui School.

The catchment area for Hiwinui School would be all properties on both sides of the roads:

- Beginning at the intersection of Watershed and Spur Roads
- Head in a south/ easterly direction down Spur Road until and including rapid number 954
- The zone travels in a southerly direction intersecting Ulysses Road at and including Rapid number 216
- We continue in a southerly direction to the intersection of Colyton and Grove Roads
- The zone follows Grove Road in a South/Westerly direction until the intersection with Ashhurst Road at and including Rapid number 742
- The Zone now travels in a South Westerly direction until the intersection of Henaghans Road and Henderson Line
- The zone follows Henaghans Road in a north/westerly direction including addresses in Simpson Lane until it joins Kelvin Grove Road.
- The Road travels in a northerly direction up Kelvin Grove Road including all addresses in Hartwell Lane until the intersection with Ashhurst Road
- The zone travels west along Ashhurst Road until Rapid number 351 and 356
- The zone travels North/West intersecting with Dixons Line at and including Rapid number 150
- The zone follows Dixons Line in a North Easterly direction until the intersection with Reids Line. The zone includes Rapid number 637 Reid Line
- The zone travels in a North/Easterly direction intersecting with Colyton Road at and including Rapid number 828 and 845
- Turn east into Colyton Road until the intersection with Watershed Road
- Turn north into Watershed Road until the beginning point at the intersection of Watershed and Spur Roads.

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority will be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in the following special programme(s) run by the school and approved by the Secretary for Education.

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary

Second Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
