



NATIONAL EARTHQUAKE DRILL AND TSUNAMI HĪKOI

SAVE YOUR TEDDY DAY

Information for students and whānau



Our school has registered to take part in national Save Your Teddy Day, coinciding with World Restart a Heart Day, where students will learn how to save a life by practicing CPR on their teddy or soft toy.

Your child's class will be participating in this fun and exciting Hato Hone St John session. This is a practical activity where they will learn and practice how to respond when a person needs care in a cardiac arrest. This means they will learn how to give CPR to their teddy or cushion.

Children will join a practical demonstration via a video which will require them to use a teddy, soft toy or cushion to practice on. Any soft toy or cushion, ideally something at least 20cm in length, would work perfectly.

Children will need to bring their teddy / soft toy or cushion to school on Save Your Teddy Day.

If your child doesn't have access to a suitable toy or cushion we may be able to support picking a pre-loved one up from a local Hato Hone St John retail store (If we have one in your location).

Please chat to the classroom teacher who has details about how you may be able to get one provided.

To help Hato Hone St John to continue to provide free CPR and AED awareness sessions we are also asking for any child participating in Save Your Teddy Day to bring a gold coin to school or you can direct donate here https://saveyourteddy.stjohn.org.nz/donate (children can still participate without providing a donation).
