**Great News!** At the end of last year, parents/caregivers were asked if they were interested in their child/ren participating in STEAM learning lessons delivered by teachers from a company called STEAM Academy by William and Stanley. They have specialised technology teachers who will come out to our school, provide all the equipment and resources needed for delivering technology lessons to your child/ren.
