Waitangi Day

Next Friday, 6 February is Waitangi Day. Our school will be closed for the public holiday, so please ensure you have adequate supervision for your tamariki.

Fruits in Schools & Breakfast Club

We are pleased to let you know that our Fruits in Schools programme and Breakfast Club will resume from **next Wednesday, 4 February**. These programmes allow us to provide all our tamariki with free fruit and breakfast each day.

The Breakfast Club runs from **8.00am to 8.30am** and offers students a healthy, balanced breakfast to help them start the day focused and ready to learn.

Swimming Lessons

Our Year 3 - 6 students will begin their swimming lessons at the Ōtara Pool and Leisure Centre on **Tuesday, 10 February** and will continue until **Tuesday, 31 March**. These are valuable lessons that teach students important water skills such as safe entry and exit, floating, basic swim strokes, and remaining calm in the water. Kāinga Ora Housing Construction

Construction has begun on the new Kāinga Ora housing development on Rongomai Road, next to our school. Work is expected to continue until June 2026.

Please take extra care when dropping off and picking up your tamariki in the mornings and afternoons, as construction vehicles may occasionally block pathways or the road.

We have been teaching our ākonga to look left and right before crossing the road. We ask that you also model this same caution when crossing with your tamariki, as our priority is ensuring everyone's safety.

Water Bottle Donation

We would like to extend a very warm thank you to the Thompson whānau, whose child Chloe (Room 6) and her family generously donated reusable water bottles to our school. These have already been distributed to our tamariki and are a great way to help keep them hydrated during the warmer weather.

Sunhat Policy

Rongomai School has a sunhat policy which means that during **Terms 1 and 4** students must wear a hat during play times. If they do not have a hat they will be directed to sit in the

shade under the canopy. This sunhat policy starts from next Monday, 2 February so please ensure your child/ren has a hat by then.
