Bilingual class 2026

Bayswater School is proud to establish a Level 3 bilingual class in 2026. This will involve teaching in two languages, where te reo Māori is used for 31-50% of the class time to deliver curriculum content.

The primary purpose of a bilingual te reo Māori class is to foster a strong foundation in the Māori language and culture through providing tamariki with the opportunity to learn and develop fluency in both te reo Māori and English.

Our bilingual journey at Bayswater School aims to:

- Provide a pathway for tamariki to learn and use te reo Māori in their daily lives.
- Connect tamariki with Aotearoa New Zealand's cultural heritage and promote a sense of belonging.
- Enhance tamariki overall academic success by providing a strong foundation in both languages.
- Contribute to the revitalisation of te reo Māori within the local community.

This initial class will be for children in years 1-3. Sasha Gillies is to be the kaiako and Lenny Rei the kaiawhina.
