At Bayswater School we have chosen to use Maths – No Problem as our mathematical programme. This is also being used at Belmont Intermediate so tamariki will get a good progression as they move on from us.

The programme is built on solid foundations of educational research and learning theories. It provides a comprehensive, effective framework for mathematics education, promoting deep understanding and long-term retention of mathematical concepts.

It is based on international best practice with an emphasis on problem-solving, visual representations of mathematical concepts and a strong emphasis on mathematical reasoning.

The design and layout of the materials has been done with accessibility in mind, ensuring effectiveness for all learners.
