For Years 1-2:

Our younger students will have the opportunity to participate in exciting day trips. These excursions are designed to complement the curriculum and provide a hands-on learning experience in a fun and safe environment.

Dates yet to be confirmed but there will be two day outings: Chipmunks Playland and a trip to the movies to watch Moana 2.

Year 3-4 Wellington Zoo Overnight Camp Details – Wednesday, 13th November

We are thrilled to share the exciting details of the upcoming Year 3-4 overnight camp at Wellington Zoo! This unique experience will give our students the chance to explore the wonders of the animal kingdom while also enjoying some fun activities along the way.

Camp Itinerary:

Wednesday, 13th November:

- **Departure:** We will depart from school in the morning at approximately 9:30am.
- **First Stop:** On our way to Wellington, we will stop at the Levin Playground for some outdoor playtime and a chance to stretch our legs.
- **Second Stop:** Our next destination is Pirate Cove Mini Golf in Porirua, where students can enjoy a round of mini-golf, followed by a refreshing swim at the Te Rauparaha Pools.
- **Dinner:** We will head to the Wellington Waterfront for dinner.
- **Wellington Zoo:** We will arrive at Wellington Zoo at 7:00 PM. After settling into our accommodation, the students will embark on an exciting night tour of the zoo, where they will get a glimpse of the nocturnal habits of the animals.

Thursday, 14th November:
