MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) Immunisations

Public Health immunisation team are offering MMR (measles mumps and rubella) immunisations.

Adults born from 1969 onwards who have not had two documented doses of the MMR vaccine should get vaccinated.

The vaccine is free for eligible adults in New Zealand and can be obtained at medical centres or pharmacies. People born before 1969 are generally considered to have immunity, and a vaccine is not indicated for them unless they are travelling to a high-risk country and have concerns.

If your child has missed any immunisation this would be a good chance to get them immunised.
