Dear Parents & Caregivers,

As we plan for 2026, we remain aware of the importance of senior students continuing to use MS Teams. At Pukekohe Christian School our Year 11-13 students use BYOD to access a suite of Microsoft applications which support learning at this level. Teachers and students use MS Teams to share files, communicate and collaborate on projects. The increased independence of study at this level, means that during study lessons, students are able to continue with their work seamlessly.

To ensure optimal functionality at school, it is important to note that **MacBooks and Chromebooks CANNOT be supported and are not permitted as BYOD. This is because several core Microsoft programs do not run on them at all.**

Any student wishing to repurpose an old laptop for BYOD must be aware that several subjects (**ICT and Photography**) require a **minimum** specification of:

- Intel 7th Generation or newer processor (or AMD equivalent with SSE4.1 support)
8GB+ RAM
- 256GB+ SSD (Hard drive)
- Windows 11

If you need to purchase a **new** laptop, the device we currently recommend is an HP G9
