**HERO -** By now you should have all received quite a few **Community feeds** on HERO (that's where we put messages for everyone - kind of like our old Messenger or School Loop messages). All parents will get these posts. You can comment/reply/ask questions on these posts.

You should also have received posts about assessments/learning too. To find these, you should click on the 3 bar menu in the top left corner beside where it says Community Feed. You should then see the options of

- 2024 Report (nothing in here yet but this is where the mid-year report will be
- Home/School Communication that's where you can send your teacher a message/photo/information (or you can just email them, text or messenger them - whatever works best for you and your child's teacher). Only you and your child's teacher will see these posts.
- Mawhero, Kakariki or Kikorangi Learning (depending on which class your child is in). Click on the class and you should see lots of posts there of your child's work results etc.. (only you will see these posts not other parents). You can comment on these posts and only your child's teacher and you will see them.

PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE - IF YOU ARE HAVING TROUBLE WITH HERO, AND NOT ABLE TO SEE POSTS or AREN'T GETTING NOTIFICATIONS - LET US KNOW AND WE CAN HELP. IT TAKES A BIT OF GETTING THE HANG OF AND SOMETIMES THE TECHNOLOGY JUST DOESN'T WORK LIKE IT IS SUPPOSED TO!
