### **Relationships and Sexuality Education**

This term the focus is around relationships. At the end of last term, I analysed our behaviour data and this told us the following:

*The behaviours outlined below are creating incidents both in class and in the playground.*

- 1. Impulsive Behaviours - these students are acting verbally or physically without any thought to their actions and the effect it has on others. In some cases, even after talking with them they still seem oblivious that their actions hurt others.*
- 2. Annoyed Behaviours - these students are reacting with words or actions at those they find annoying. The other person can be on the other side of the class or unaware they are being annoying as there is no warning to them by the other student to stop what they are doing.*
- 3. Unfair Behaviours - these students react when they don't get their own way. The reasons for their behaviours are often quite trivial but their reactions are not.*

*Each class will be running their own sessions to unpack these behaviours and help the students develop strategies to use when these situations arise.*

### **ERO - Education Review Office**

*ERO as well as undertaking school reviews, the education review office undertake research into different education initiatives and then present the findings back to schools, the Ministry of Education and the Government.*

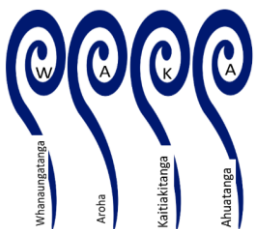

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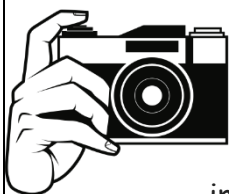

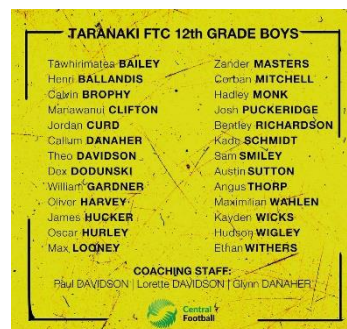


### School Photos
