KEEPING OUR COLWILL TAMARIKI SAFE.

We have had several reports of our Colwill tamariki who have **NOT** been crossing roads safely and running in front of cars. As a Travelwise/travel-safe school, we aim to improve our tamariki's road safety knowledge to keep them safe.

We ask you to please korero with your children about road safety and where the safe places are to cross.

3 TIPS TO KEEP OUR CHILDREN SAFE.

- Use the school pedestrian crossing even when you are with an adult.
- All children with a scooter or bike must wear a helmet to and from school. No helmet = no bike or scooter.
- Always look both ways before you cross the road – even at a pedestrian crossing.
