Strike

We have informally been notified that all NZEI (Education Union) staff, principals, teachers and teacher aides will be on strike on Thursday October 23rd. This will mean the school will have to close as there will not be sufficient staff to keep the school open.

Why are we striking?

We want a fair pay offer that will encourage more people to become teachers and stay in teaching. We are asking for better resourcing so we can give support to children who need it. We want investment in external services to support students with additional needs. We want a change to how support staff (teacher aides) are funded and given job security. Principals have not even received an offer from the Government after months of bargaining.

We appreciate that a strike upsets routines and has an impact on families. We would appreciate it if you could let your local MP Miles Anderson waitaki.mp@parliament.govt.nz Ph 03 4347325 and the Minister of Education Erica Stanford E.Stanford@ministers.govt.nz know that a decent offer should be given to Principals, teachers and support staff.


Touch
