This has been emailed to you on Wednesday 28 August. Please check your spam folders.


We ask that this be completed by Friday 6 September.

Next week we are collecting cans for St Vinnies. It would be wonderful to see the tamariki bringing a can to school to support this wonderful organisation who do so much for our kura.



Ember Days



Ember Days

The Church celebrates Smber Days four times each year. They are tied to the changing of the seasons, but also to the liturgical cycles of the Church.

The dates for the Ember days are the Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday following:

- † The feast of St. Lucy
- † Ash Wednesday
- † Pentecost Sunday
- † Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross



Ember days are observed with fasting (I regular meal + 2 smaller meals, no food between meals) and partial abstinence, meaning that meat is allowed at one meal per day. Complete abstinence from meat is required on Ember Friday. As always such an observence has a greater purpose:

† To thank God for the gifts he gives us through nature

Supervision policy and procedures, which states it is our school's expectation that students have left the school grounds by 3.25pm, we are changing how students are supervised at the end of the day/pick up time to ensure their safety. Effective from 24 July 2024 any students who are not collected by 3.15pm (after the departure of our last bus) will be moved to the walkway outside our staff room and Eden classroom, where they will remain seated until they are collected by a parent/caregiver. Parents/caregivers will need to enter our school via the office gate and check in with the supervising teacher in the staffroom to advise of the pick up. Please also ensure your child/ren knows who is collecting them each day. If for any reason someone different is collecting your child from school, please contact the office to advise. This decision has been made for the safety of all our students and we thank you for your continued support.

Savoury Muffins

- 1½ cups self-raising flour (or regular flour and 1 teaspoon of baking powder)
- · 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup milk
- 1 egg
- 200g grated/crumbled cheese (a little less is OK, and any kind of cheese works.
 Try a cheddar/blue cheese mix fresh parmesan is good too)
- Savoury fillings caramelised onions, mushrooms, chopped up cooked chorizo, spinach, roasted red pepper, roasted pumpkin/kumara, feta cubes. You can add almost anything you like!
- 1. Mix the dry ingredients, including the cheese and savoury fillings. Mix carefully to avoid mashing all the ingredients together. You can add a pinch of paprika or black pepper to the mix to taste.
- 2. Mix the wet ingredients well.
- 3. Combine wet and dry ingredients together. Be careful not to over mix it should be a stiff mixture.
- 4. Spoon into greased muffin tins, garnishing the top. (A slice of tomato and some grated cheese works well, as do pumpkin seeds)
- 5. Cook at 190°C for 20 minutes or until muffins are browned.
