
Our Lady of Lourdes





Periods are a fact of life yet they can be the cause of much anxiety, particularly for students who have difficulty accessing period products, like tampons and pads. The initiative is currently being rolled out to all schools and kura across New Zealand. The research suggested schools and kura should create systems that allow students to access period products easily, discreetly and when they need them (See Mrs Winter or Mrs Whitmore at any time). St Patrick's School recognises that access to period products is a necessity, not a luxury. We have placed an order for period products and will have these available for our students in the very near future. Mrs Winter and Mrs Whitmore are available throughout the school day, so please feel free to pop in at any stage and they will ensure access is available discreetly.









Sunhats - Term 1 - Sunhats are to be worn this term during all breaks.. No child will be allowed to play in the sun without a sunhat on. \$15.00 for a new sunhat which can be purchased from the school office.







Please make contact with the school office for a consent form if medication is to be given during school hours.

Protect your child against serious diseases

If your child is in Year 7 or Year 8, they will be offered **free** immunisations at most schools to help protect them against serious diseases such as **diphtheria**, **tetanus**, **whooping cough** and **most cancers caused by HPV**.

Your child will bring home a Parent Consent Form which has more information. To make sure your child receives their school immunisations, remember to sign and return the consent form to school.
