
If you have an interest you would like to share with the students on Friday afternoons we would love to hear from you.

Sri Lankan Cultural Week starting Monday 24 March




Monday 24 March we will be participating in Sri Lankan Sport in the afternoon. Students can wear school sport uniforms to school on this day.


