
St Patrick's School places a high value on attendance at school. Regular attendance at school helps build and maintain a child's learning, establishes positive daily routines, and promotes well being by connecting them to their peers.

One of the things we are continuing to focus on in 2025 is student attendance.

If a student misses one day of school every two weeks, they miss more than a whole year of school by 16 years of age. As a parent or caregiver, you, alongside our school, play a key role in building strong habits of regular school attendance.

All students are legally required to attend school every day and it is a shared responsibility to make sure students attend and engage in learning from when they first start school.

You must let the school know if your child is going to be absent or intends to be absent for a portion of the school term for whatever reason, like a tangi or medical procedure. Family holidays or taking time off

Your proactive notification helps our office administrators focus their time and energy on other essential tasks. This leads to a smoother operation and better support for all students and parents


