School closure update for Saint Patrick's School whanau 19.11.25.

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Our Board of Trustees and I have been working together to provide you with this update. This is an unprecedented and challenging situation for all of us. Our actions are based upon a safe return to school as soon as we are able.

We will continue to provide updates to you when we have any further information via email and Skool Loop.

Next steps:

- **Timeframe** We have obtained a timeframe from the asbestos testers and cleaners. Testing to be completed hopefully by Tuesday next week (25 November) and results by Friday next week hopefully (28 November). The provider is very busy with many school closures due to this but they are prioritising schools
- As it stands it is unlikely we will be able to reopen until Tuesday 2 December (due to Westland Holiday on 1 December). This is contingent on testing going ahead on schedule and no contamination being found
- If contamination is found there is no current timeline on how long it will take to deep clean or what areas of the school may or may not be open. We will be able to plan for this hopefully at the end of next week when we have the testing results available
- If no contamination is found may open fully on the Tuesday 2 December

- If partial contamination is found we will open as many areas of our school as deemed safe by our asbestos tester/ cleaner
- In the meantime we are looking for alternate options to provide learning spaces/ opportunities for students and will communicate these as soon as we are able to draw a plan together
- We cannot access many of the schools resources or Chromebooks left behind due to the contamination risk

What can you do at home:

Guidance from the Ministry of Education released overnight provides guidance on personal decontamination and can be found at this link:

As far as we know the last time the sand was used was two weeks ago. Based on the above guidance I suggest that you treat any exposure as a historic one. The information provided by the Ministry of Education suggests the following:

If sand use was historical and clothing has been washed

The risk of residual contamination is very low to negligible. Any remaining particles are likely to have been removed through washing.

We are very conscious it is difficult for you having children at home especially in the lead up to Christmas. If you cannot provide care for your children during school hours please could you email me directly:

For now our school remains closed to all students.

The Board and I will be meeting daily to review the situation. We will communicate any updates as soon as we have them.

Closing the school is not taken lightly but balanced against the risk no matter how small of wellbeing for students and staff.






