

We do still need helpers for St Patrick's athletics this Thursday. Please let Ms. Shannahan know if you can help.


Reminder, Toys and balls are not to come into school unless they are requested by the class teacher such as teddy bears picnic for instance.




Bus children need to wear their fluro vests in the morning and afternoon. This is not an option, it is compulsory.




Keeping our students safe outside our school.


